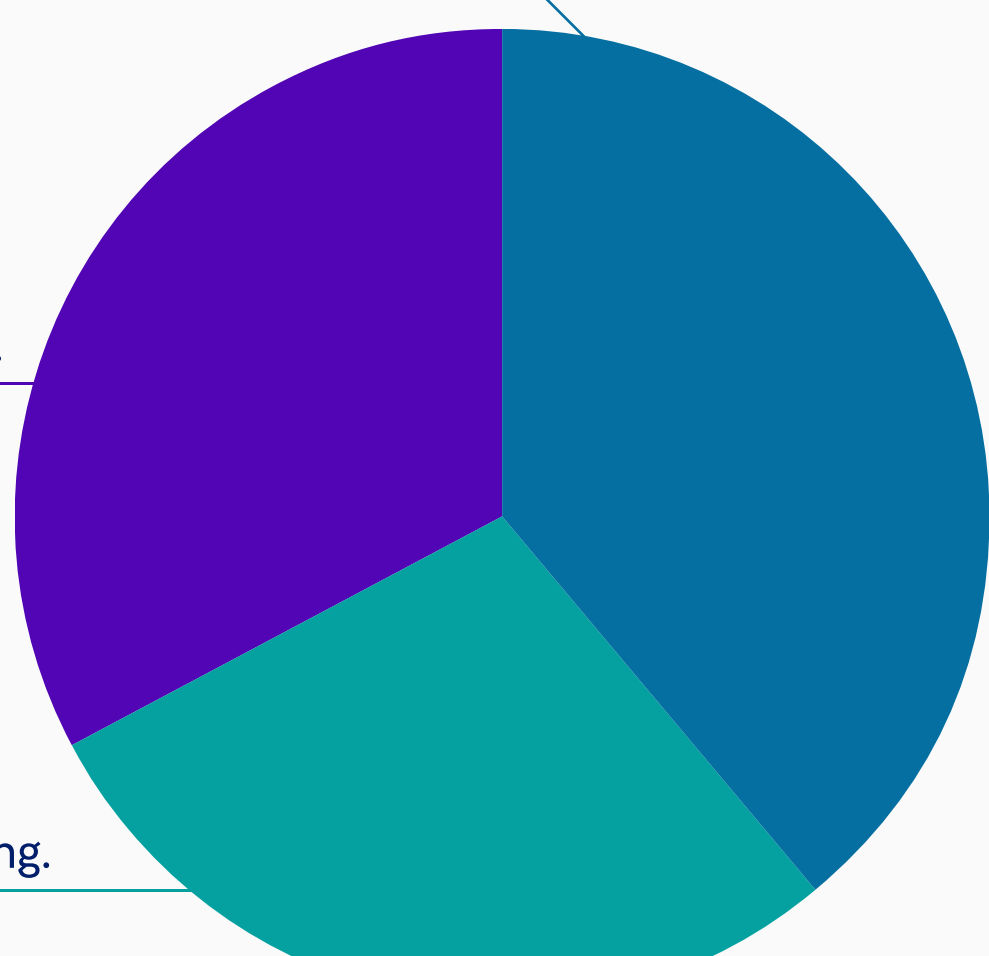

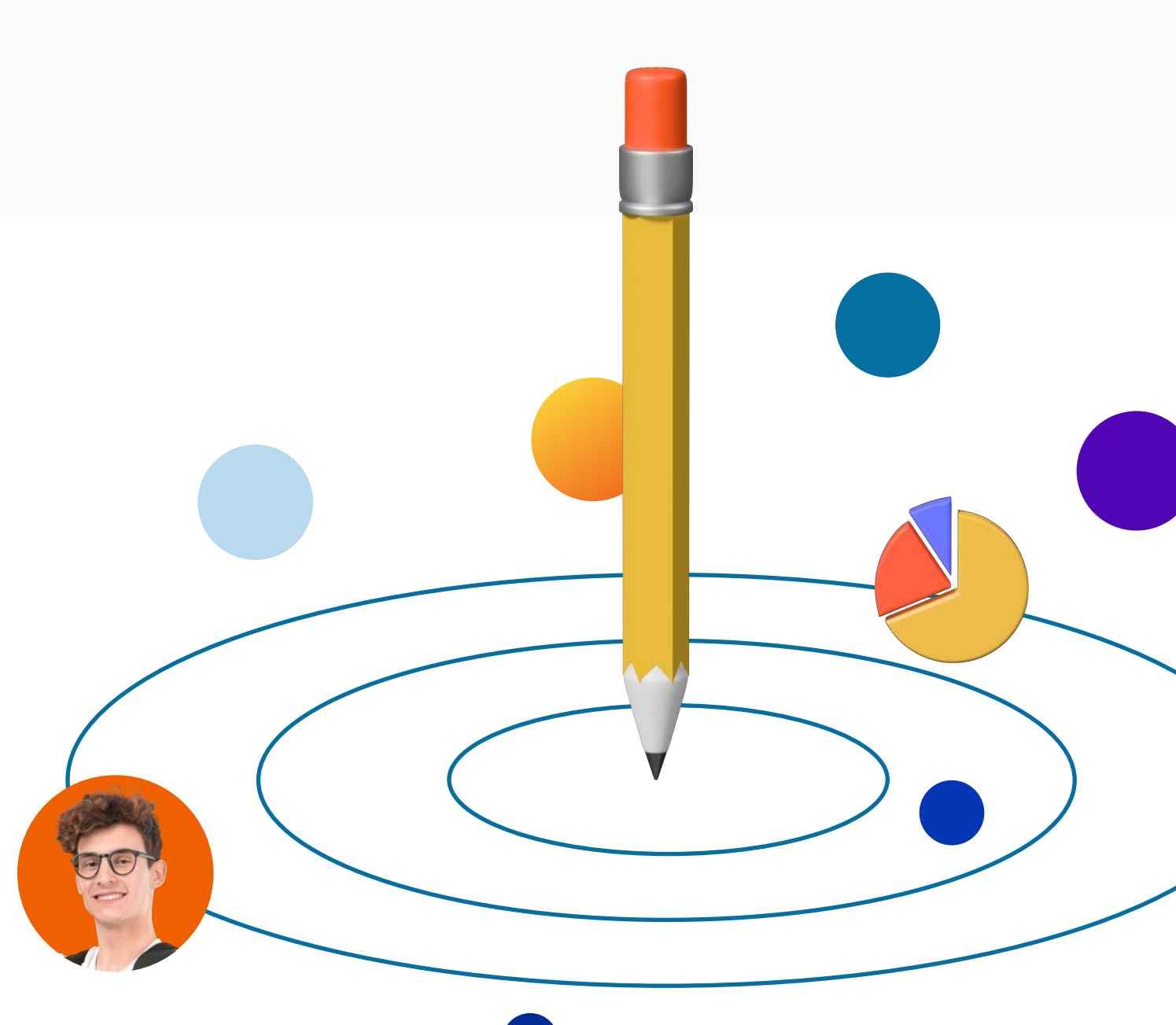

## The Current State of Learning Loss

Disruptions in grades K-12 education due to the pandemic resulted in the largest learning loss in two decades<sup>1</sup> – with the highest disparity between high and low poverty school districts.<sup>2</sup>

## What is High-Dosage Tutoring?

High-dosage tutoring is a proven intervention method to quickly overcome learning loss, with a target focus on a student's specific needs and learning style.



### What high-dosage tutoring is:

- ✓ Accessible to all
- ✓ Intensive 1-to-1 or small group sessions
- ✓ An opportunity for a qualified tutor to develop a consistent relationship with the student
- ✓ Individualized – and aligned with the classroom curriculum
- ✓ Responsive to student needs

### What it is not:

- ✗ For struggling students only, or treated as a punishment
- ✗ Intermittent or “homework help”
- ✗ Provided by an unqualified tutor or a different tutor each session
- ✗ Reliant on the student to opt into
- ✗ Lacking context or engagement

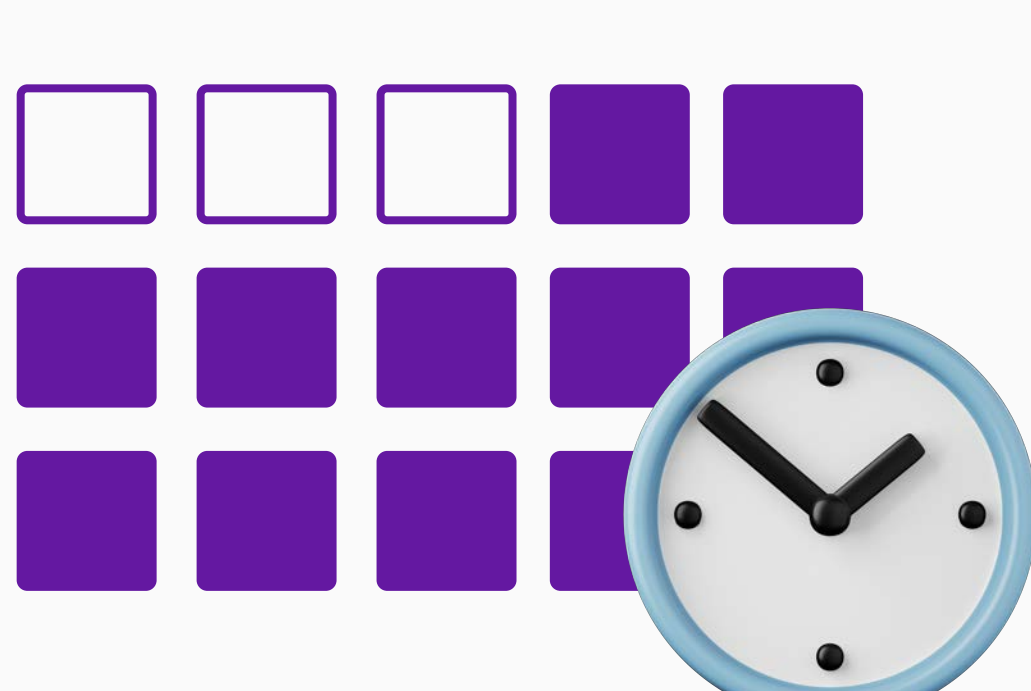

## Why School Districts Should Consider High-Dosage Tutoring.

High-dosage tutoring can create learning gains for students who have fallen behind academically.<sup>3,5</sup>



Approximately three-to-fifteen months of lost learning can be recovered with high-dosage tutoring.



But without it, student learning recovery is an uphill climb – and learning recovery can take up to:

**3 years or less**

For elementary school students.

**5 years or less**

For middle school students.

Research has shown that remediation or a simplified curriculum will only result in students falling further behind academically.<sup>4</sup>

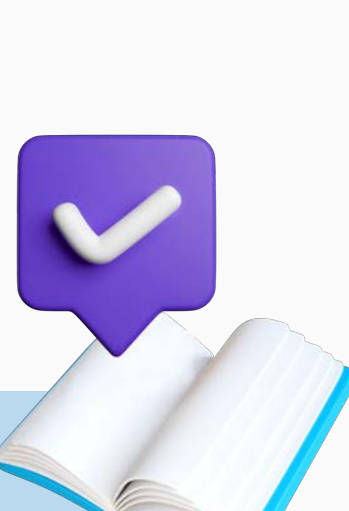
## How Does It Work?

The flexibility of online learning can also help educators to extend their classrooms and conduct tutoring sessions during the school day.

**1.**

### Individualized

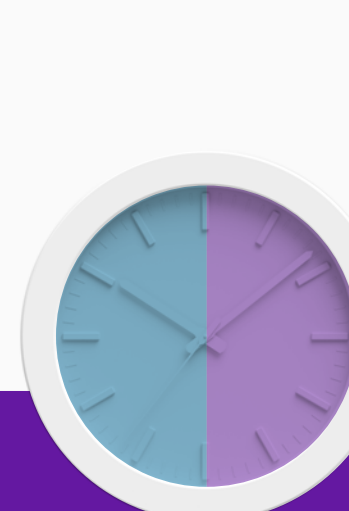
State-certified teachers tutor small groups of up to four students.



**2.**

### Intensive

Live tutoring will consist of 30-to-60 minute sessions.



**3.**

### Repetition

Groups meet three times per week. Then repeat.



### Did You Know?

One academic year of high-dosage tutoring can provide the equivalent of 19 weeks of instruction.
